



First Aid

	Remove patient to fresh air, lay down and rest.	
Smoke Inhalation	• If patient is not breathing make sure airway is clear and apply artificial respiration.	
Shicke Initialation	Keep patient warm	
	Call doctor at once or transport to Doctor or Hospital	
Гурар	Hold eyes open and wash continuously with water for 15 minutes	
Eyes	Transport to Doctor or Hospital	
Skin	Wash affected areas with water using soap	
	Immerse affected area in cold water for 10 to 15 minutes	
Burne	Bandage lightly with sterile dressing	
Burns	Treat for shock, if required
